

FILING MULTIPLE MOTIONS IN ONE PLEADING

Civil Cases

In civil cases, multiple motions can be filed in one pleading by holding down the “Ctrl” key and clicking on the desired motions. **Important Exception:** When the multiple motions are the same motion, the motions must be filed in separate pleadings.

Examples:

1. A motion to compel and a motion to continue can be filed in one pleading.
2. Multiple motions in limine must be filed separately in separate pleadings.

Criminal Cases

The functionality to file multiple motions in one document is not available in criminal cases. Motions in criminal cases can only request one form of relief.
